The school will:

- Provide the highest quality education for all students.
- Provide a safe and caring environment.
- Encourage all students to fulfil their potential and provide them with the means to do so.
- Promote the values of respect for others, self-respect, honesty and a pride in personal appearance.
- Provide an extensive range of extra-curricular activities.
- Set, mark and monitor homelearning tasks which extend learning.
- Consult with parents/carers and keep them regularly informed of all relevant matters.
- Keep parents/carers informed about the progress of their child/ward, including absenteeism and lack of punctuality.

Parents/Carers (I/We) will:

- Support the school's aims, objectives, vision and ethos.
- Ensure the correct school uniform is worn.
- Ensure my child/ward's full attendance at, and punctuality to, school.
- Not take holidays in term time, in line with school policy.
- Notify the school if my child/ward cannot attend school for any reason.
- Ensure my child/ward adheres to the ICT agreement.
- Attend Parents/Carers' Evenings and discussions about my child/ward's progress.
- Encourage participation in extra-curricular activities and wider school life.
- Ensure homelearning tasks are completed on time.
- Ensure my child/ward attends after-school detentions when given 24 hours' notice.
- Support the school policy on discipline and sanctions including rules on the use of mobile phones, the wearing of jewellery etc.
- Behave in line with the expectations outlined in the school's Parental Behaviour Protocol.

Students in all year groups will:

- Behave well travelling to and from school.
- Attend school regularly and on time, and never leave school without permission.
- Wear correct school uniform and bring all equipment needed to school.
- Behave well inside and outside the classroom, and on any school visits.
- Speak to staff courteously and respect the student/teacher relationship.
- Follow all reasonable and appropriate requests made by members of staff.
- Work as hard as possible in school.

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- Complete all homelearning tasks to the best of my ability.
- Show self-respect, respect for property and respect for others at all times.
- Sign the ICT agreement and adhere to it at all times.
- Ensure substances harmful to health, or any items under the 'prohibited' list in the Behaviour Policy, are not brought into school.
