A Level Results Day 2020

I am writing to you to provide the arrangements for A Level results day on **Thursday 13 August.** Under normal circumstances, we would invite students into school on results day to celebrate your success and support you with your next steps. Due to the current situation however, we must make some changes to the way we operate, to ensure the safety of all staff and students.

Therefore, please note the following:

- School will be open from 8am for students to collect results
- Students collecting results must maintain social distance from other students and staff at all times
- Students will enter the Sixth Form via the side door by the main school entrance and follow the directions up to the drama studio to collect their results
- Students will then exit down the south staircase (next to 624) and out through the Sixth Form reception
- For students who have not gained a place at University, or would like to change their destination, you can access support from staff in the Learning Resource Centre. You will also have access to telephones to contact Universities should you need to do so

Unfortunately, given the current restrictions on gatherings, we will only be able to accommodate students on site. We politely ask that family members remain outside the school building.

Further information relating to the appeals process and how to access this will be available for collection on results day itself.
