Classroom Behaviour & Expectations

Travelling to school:

- Students must only come into school on their allocated days.
- The start of the school day is 10:00am. Students should not arrive before 9:50am.
- If students are walking to school, they must maintain social distancing at all times.
- TFGM have issued guidance that will be distributed on how they expect students to operate on the busses and this does include the wearing of a face covering. For more details, please visit: https://tfgm.com/.
- If arriving by car, social distancing when disembarking must be adhered to and students should remain socially distant from others alighting from buses or other cars.
- If using a bicycle, this must be stored and locked in the bike shed. Students will always need to keep helmets/personal belongings with them, as there will be no access to lockers.
- All students will be greeted at the school gates by a member of staff at the student walkway and will be given directions to their classroom.

Classroom:

- Classrooms have been redesigned to comply with social distancing regulations.
- Students will only use one classroom for the duration of the day.
- Rooms will be given a deep clean at the end of each day.
- Seating plans will be in place and students must not leave their seats or their classroom unless asked to do so by a member of staff.
- Registers will be taken by class teachers delivering each lesson.
- All students must bring their own stationery.
- All students will be given their own A4 paper and zip seal wallet to store work in. These will remain in school and must not be taken home.
- The 3 R's will still apply whereby we expect all students to be Ready to learn,
 Respectful of others and acting in a Responsible manner.
- All students meeting these expectations will be entered into a weekly prize draw and celebrated for their efforts in maintaining safety for all.

Outside the classroom:

- Students must always comply with social distancing regulations.
- Hand sanitiser dispensers have been installed and should be used as often as possible.
- Hand washing with soap and hot water for 20 seconds will be encouraged as often as possible.
- Additional toilets and hand-washing facilities are now in place.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottle and packed lunch. Students should not share items of food or drink.
- The school canteen will be open and will offer a small range of food and drinks.

In a bid to ensure that all students and staff are kept as safe as possible any student who does not adhere to the measures put in place will be sent home.
