



Dear Parents/Carers

I am delighted to offer students in Years 7, 8 and 9 the opportunity to join our Homework Club. There are sessions from 3.15-4.15pm every Monday (for Year 7), Tuesday (for Year 8) and Thursday (for Year 9).

If students are scheduled to attend intervention lessons (Year 7) or 'My Tutor' sessions (Year 8 & 9) after school on the same day, they must attend these sessions instead of homework club.

Some students may be able to take advantage of our late school bus services, depending on their address. Buses will leave school at 4.30pm. This term we have three services: one to Oldfield Brow/Broadheath, one to Sale/ Sale Moor and one to Baguley/Wythenshawe. The routes are very similar to those run every day for the 771/2, 773 and 774 school services (please see routes attached); however, please be aware that these late buses are organized separately from the usual school services and are operated by different providers.

These buses will be free of charge for this term.

Naturally, students who join homework club must adhere to normal school rules and they must bring suitable work. This is an ideal opportunity for your child/ward to complete homework in a quiet, supervised room and receive help from a member of staff.

Sessions will start next week (Monday 26 April 2021).
