










'I enjoy the debates we have in class and learning how the government works.'


'Politics is so relevant to everyone and you learn about current affairs all over the world'.

'The best part about the debates is that they allow you to rationalise what your thoughts are, the counter arguments and whether or not you want to change your mind'.




