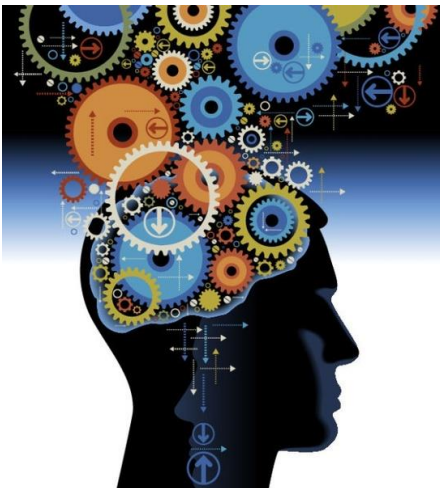
# Philosophy & Ethics: Sixth Form Opinions

‘It’s interesting to learn about other cultures and their responses to modern events and issues’.

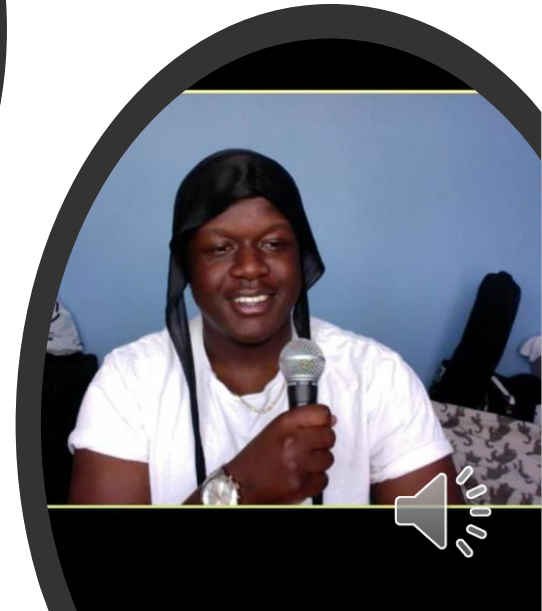

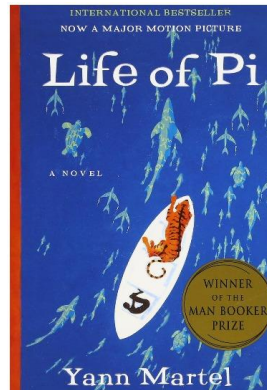
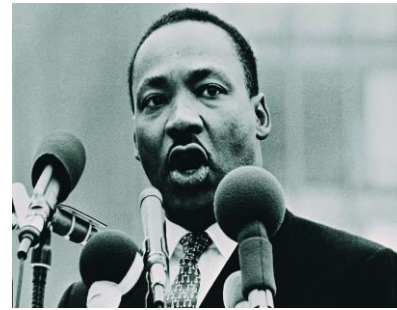
