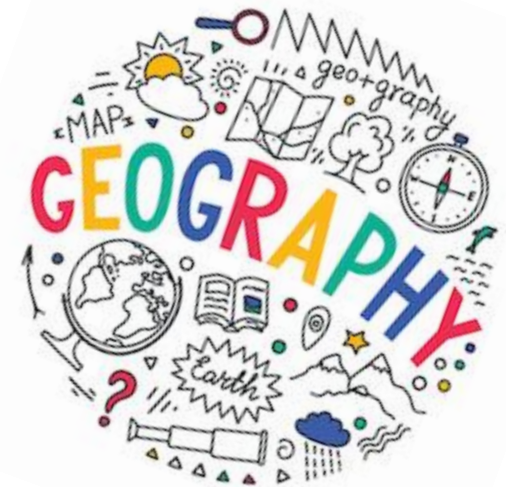

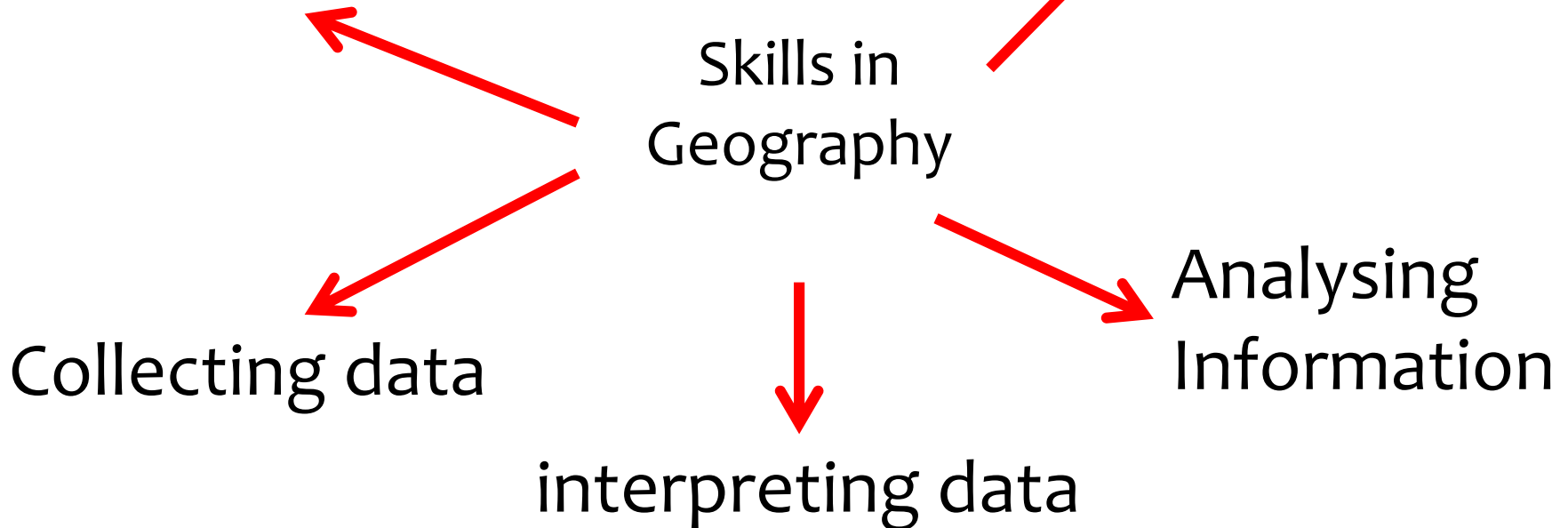


What Skills Will I Develop?

These skills are in great demand and are recognised by employers and universities and colleges as being of great value.

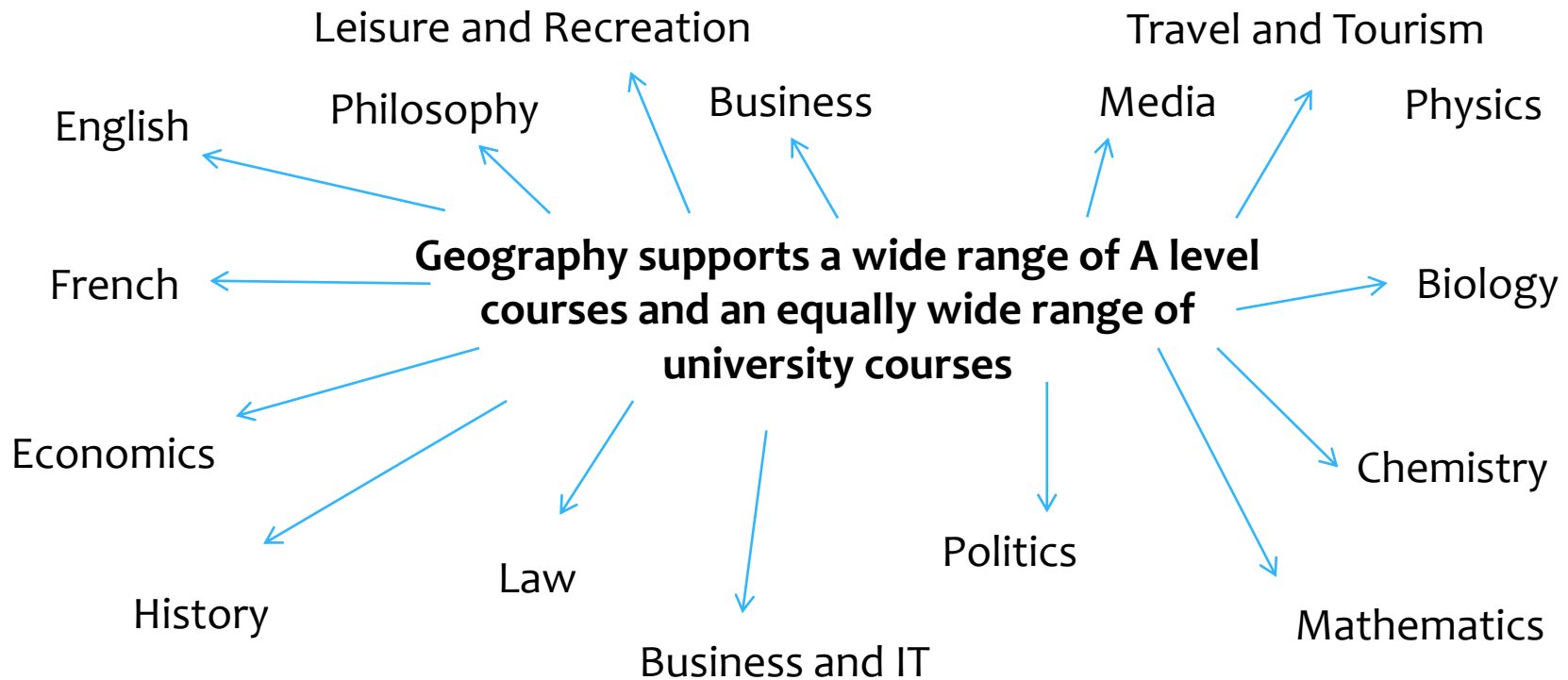


What could I go on to do at the end of my course?
