Results Day

- A Level Results Day is Thursday 18 August 2022
- Don't leave the country!
- School is open 8.30-11.30am
- UCAS updates at 8am
- UCAS won't give you your results, it will only tell you if you have been accepted by your firm/insurance university.

Results Day Offers

If you make your firm offer

Congratulations! Your offer will change to '<u>Unconditional Firm</u>' You'll then receive detail on what to do next from the University

If you miss your firm offer

- Check UCAS there is a chance the university might accept you anyway
- Your firm choice might accept you, but make you an alternative course ('a changed course offer') e.g. foundation year
- Check to see if you have been accepted by your insurance choice
- You can apply to different universities through Clearing

Clearing...



- If you aren't accepted by your firm or insurance choice, you can apply through Clearing
- Clearing is not just for students with low exam results. If you have done better than expected, or have changed your mind, you can apply through Clearing.
- **THERE ARE GOOD COURSES IN CLEARING.** Any course can enter Clearing if the university has places they want to fill.
- The good places get snapped up quickly (often before 12pm). Do your research now if you don't get the grades, where else could you apply? What is your Plan B?
- Register your interest with universities ahead of Results Day take a look on the university's website.

On the day - the Clearing process... UC/S

- If you are in Clearing, your UCAS status will say, 'You are now in Clearing'
- Your Clearing number will appear in UCAS Hub.
- Contact the university that you are interested in.
- It can take a long time to get through so be patient. Contact as many universities as you like, but you can only accept one offer.
- If they make you an offer, you can add a Clearing choice in Track from 15:00 on Results Day.
- Once you've accepted an offer, you might be invited to a Clearing Open Day at the university.



Clearing Tips



- Prepare in advance- research alternative courses and universities <u>now</u>
- On Results Day: If you speak to a university about a course vacancy, they may ask you for: your UCAS ID, Clearing Number, Exam Results, questions about your Personal Statement.
- Prepare a list of questions for you to ask them: i.e. 'do you have guaranteed accommodation for students applying through Clearing?'
- Get informal offers from universities over the phone then decide which one you want to accept.
- Ask the university to confirm any verbal offers by email.
