LABOUR MARKET INFORMATION FACT

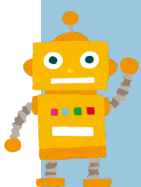

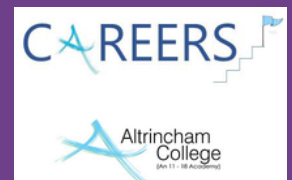
