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## PERSONAL EQUIPMENT RENTAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The equipment is owned and hired by GRIP Expeditions, a company registered in England and Wales (registered number 8064759) whose registered office is Norwood House, 96 Navigation Road, Altrincham, Cheshire, WA14 1LL. This is an important document and will create legally binding obligations on you. If you do not understand anything set out in it, you should take legal advice before entering into a contract with us.

Every effort is made to provide safe and well maintained equipment. All customers must take full responsibility for the kit that they hire, and know how to use it, store it and return it. The following policy is to safeguard all parties.

### CLEANING

You must return the equipment to us free of mud and dirt and must be completely dry before being returned to us to avoid mildew or mould. Rucksacks and sleeping bags must be empty of rubbish, grass, sand and dirt. Sleeping bag liners must be used in sleeping bags for hygiene purposes. Any sleeping bag returned to us without a liner having been used will incur a professional cleaning fee of £40. Any other item returned to us in an unclean condition will incur a cleaning charge of £20.

### DAMAGE, LOSS, THEFT or NON-RETURN

Our rental fee assumes a limited amount of wear and tear, which may occur with a normal use. However, rips, tears, burn holes, excessive dirt or stains, mildew, or missing parts noted upon return will result in additional charges, for repair or replacement.

The customer is responsible for the equipment at all times between collection and return. Stolen or lost equipment will result in additional charges for like-for-like replacements.

### CANCELLATIONS

If you cancel your order in writing more than seven days ahead of the scheduled collection date, then you will not incur a cancellation fee. Any cancellations within seven days of the scheduled collection date will incur a 50% rental fee.

### LIABILITY

GRIP Expeditions is not responsible for any personal injury incurred while using our rental equipment or anytime you have the gear in your possession or otherwise. It is understood and agreed that there are inherent dangers associated with camping, hiking, cooking and any other activity you may engage in while using our equipment.

We do not expressly or otherwise guarantee or warrant the rental gear for any specific performance or purpose other than as it is described. If any item malfunctions or fails to perform as it is described, you agree our maximum liability to you is the rental cost associated with that item. It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with each item, to check the items prior to each use, and to use them properly.

Weather conditions in the UK and Europe are temperamental. It is the users' responsibility to check forecasts and use the equipment properly to get the best performance from it.
