You need to be able to identify the following instruments when playing. You can revise this by searching on you tube and listening to examples.

WOODWIND FAMILY

Flute. Clarinet. Saxophone.

BRASS FAMILY

Trumpet. Trombone. Tuba.

STRING FAMILY

Violin. Cello. Double Bass.

PERCUSSION FAMILY

Bass Drum. Snare Drum. Cymbals. Glockenspiel.

DYNAMICS

Memorise these words for dynamics (volume) in Music

Pianissimo – Very Quiet

Piano – Quiet

Mezzo Piano – Moderately Quiet

Mezzo Forte – Moderately Loud

Forte – Loud

Fortissimo – Very Loud

Crescendo – Getting Louder

Decrescendo – Getting Softer

TEMPO

Memorise these words for tempo (speed) in Music

Lento – slow

Moderato – Moderately

Allegro – Fast

Accelerando – Getting Faster

Rallentando- Getting Slower

DURATION

Make sure you understand what the note symbols look and sound like for;

Semibreves

Minims

Crotchets

Quavers

PITCH

Make sure you know where to draw the note pitches on the stave in treble clef Middle C (below the stave) to F at the top of the stave. Remember notes in the spaces spell **FACE**, notes on the lines are **EGBDF** (Every Good Boy Deserves Football)
