DYNAMICS

Memorise these words for dynamics (volume) in Music

Pianissimo – Very Quiet Piano – Quiet Mezzo Piano – Moderately Quiet Mezzo Forte – Moderately Loud Forte – Loud Fortissimo – Very Loud Crescendo – Getting Louder Decrescendo – Getting Softer

TEMPO

Memorise these words for tempo (speed) in Music

Lento – slow Moderato – Moderately Allegro – Fast Accelerando – Getting Faster Rallentando- Getting Slower

DURATION

Make sure you understand what the note symbols look and sound like for;

Semibreves Minims Crotchets Quavers

PITCH

Make sure you know where to draw the note pitches on the stave in treble clef Middle C (below the stave) to F at the top of the stave. Remember notes in the spaces spell **FACE**, notes on the lines are **EGBDF** (Every Good Boy Deserves Football)
