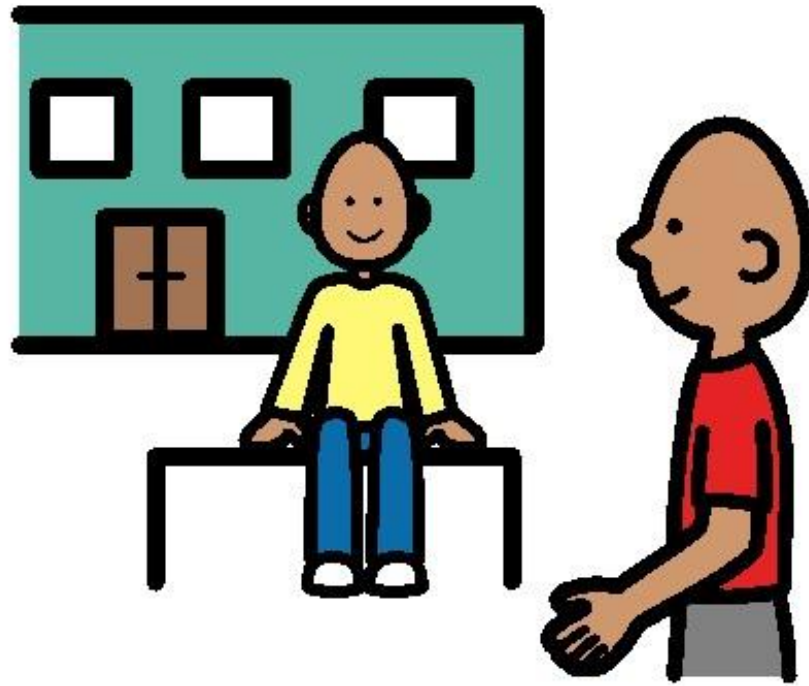

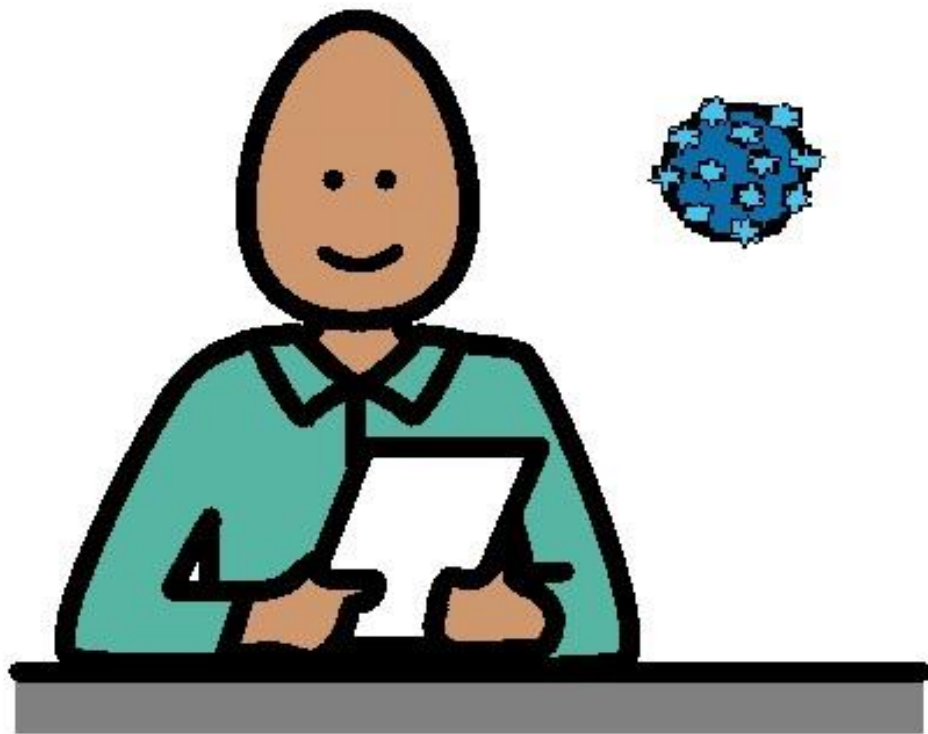

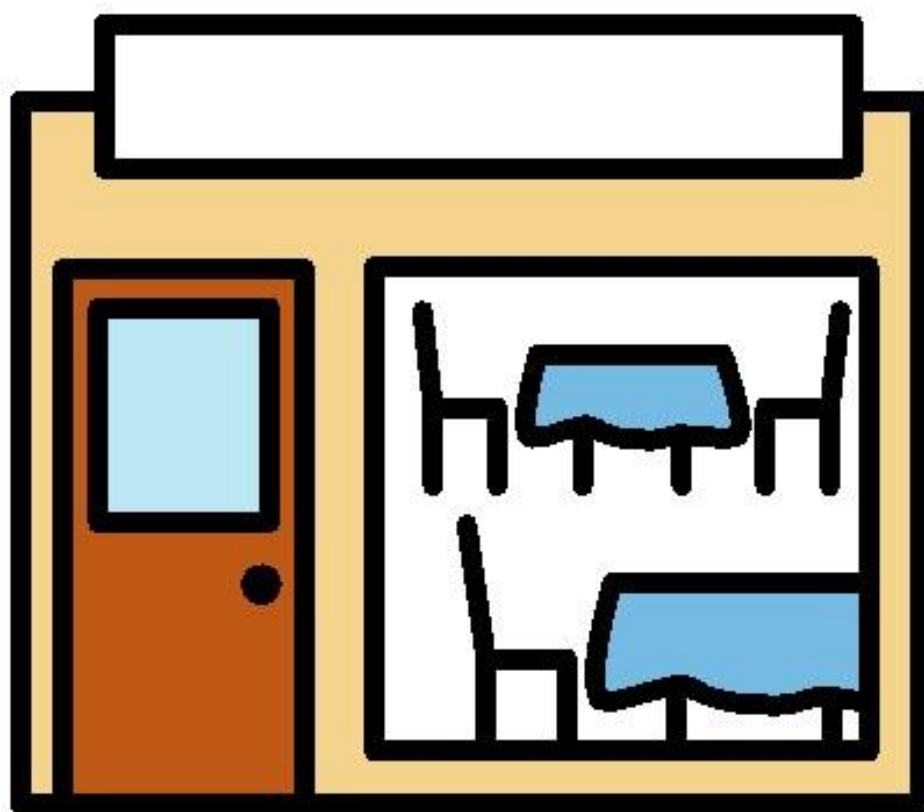
We have done a

staying at home.



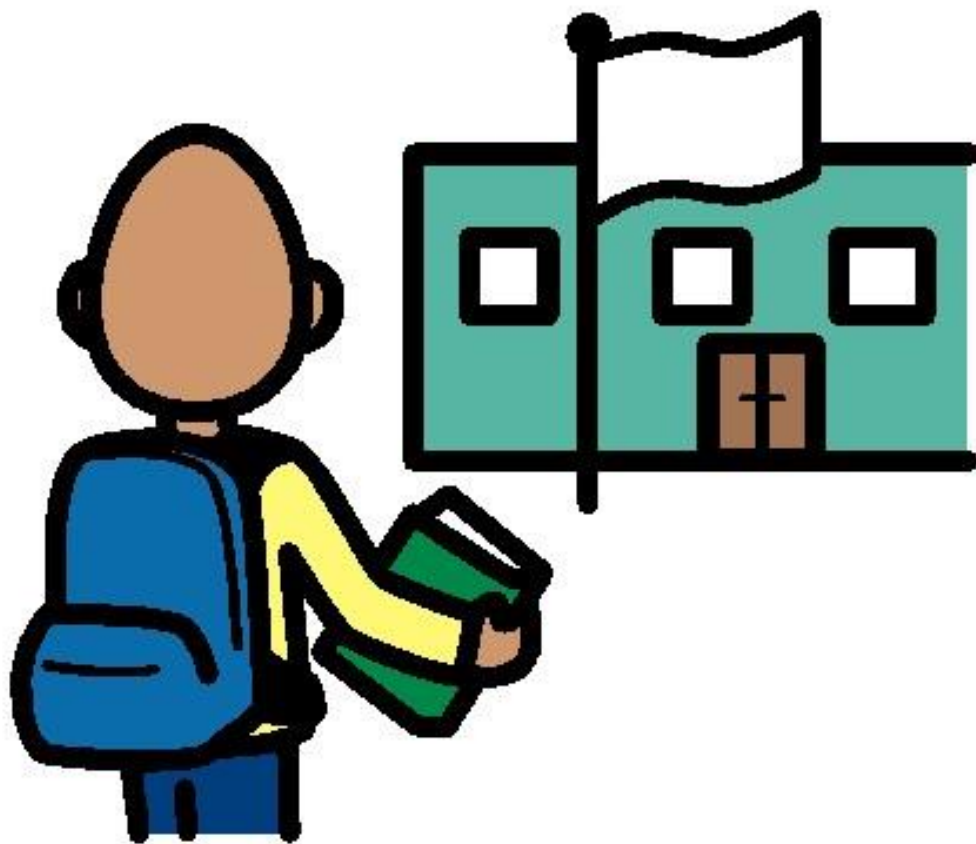
Less people are

the Corona virus.



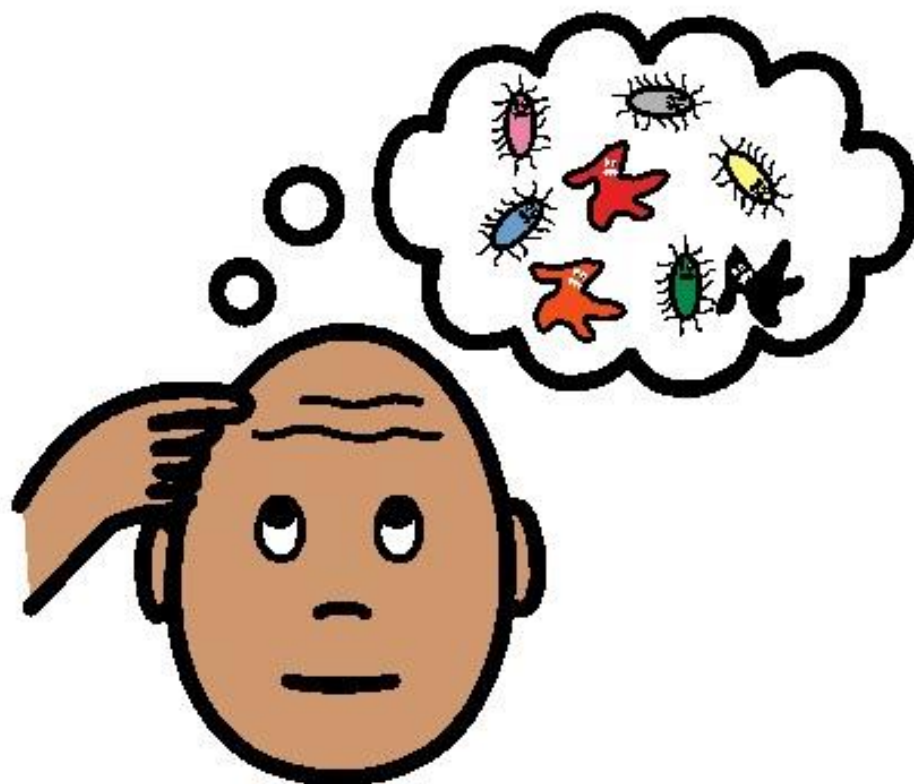
Some places will

reopening soon!

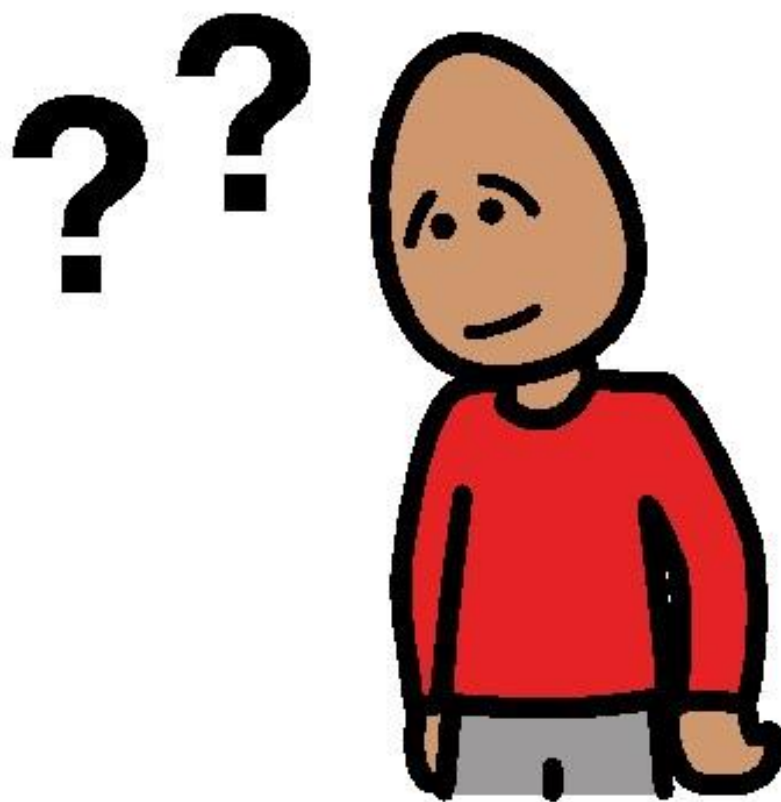


We need to be

different at school.



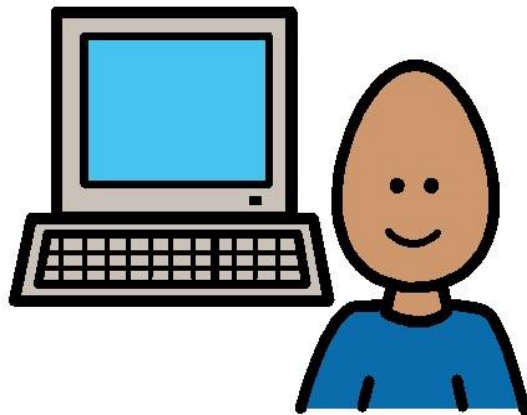
Some teachers will  
stay at home.



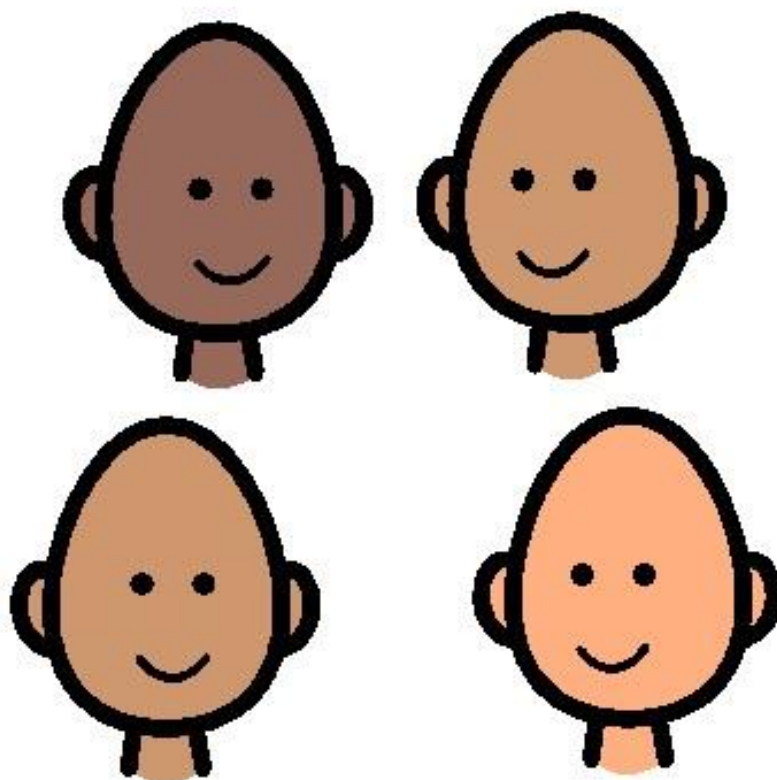
Some students will  
stay at home.



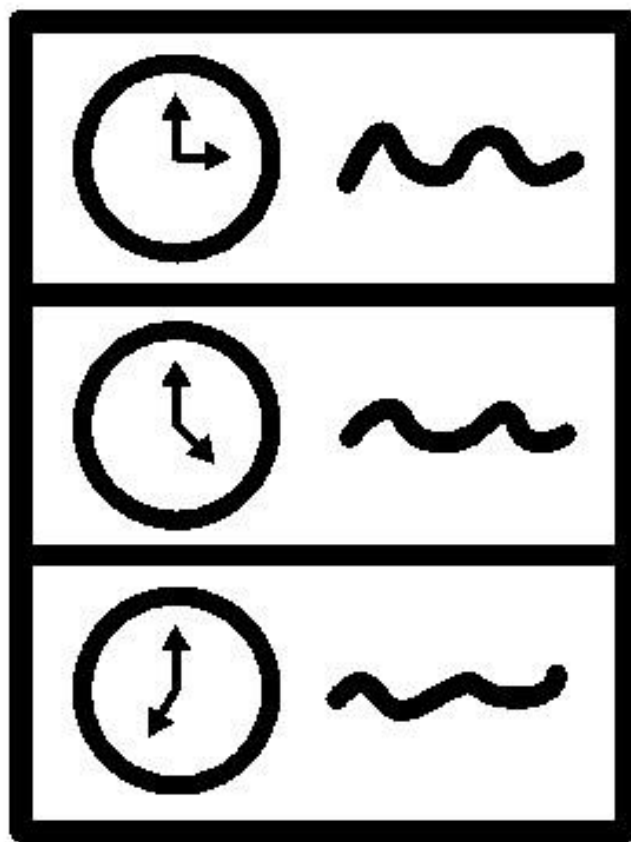
Learning will take

and online.



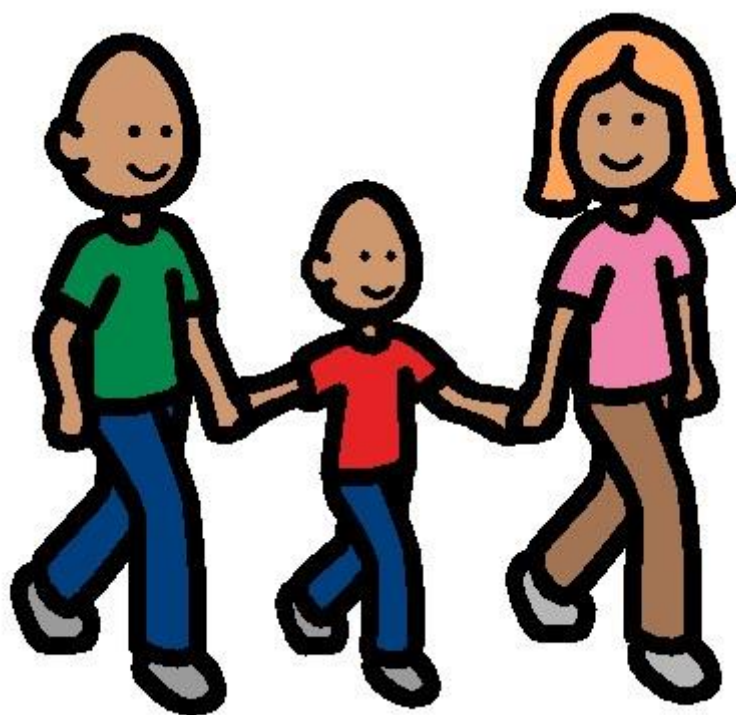
Students who come

Parents might be asked to stay out of the building to limit the amount of people inside.

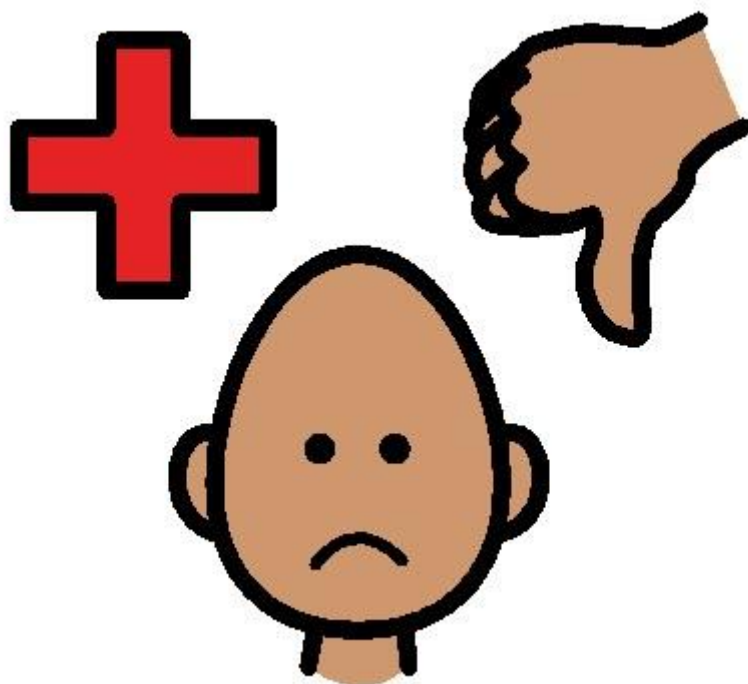


Everyone entering

are healthy.

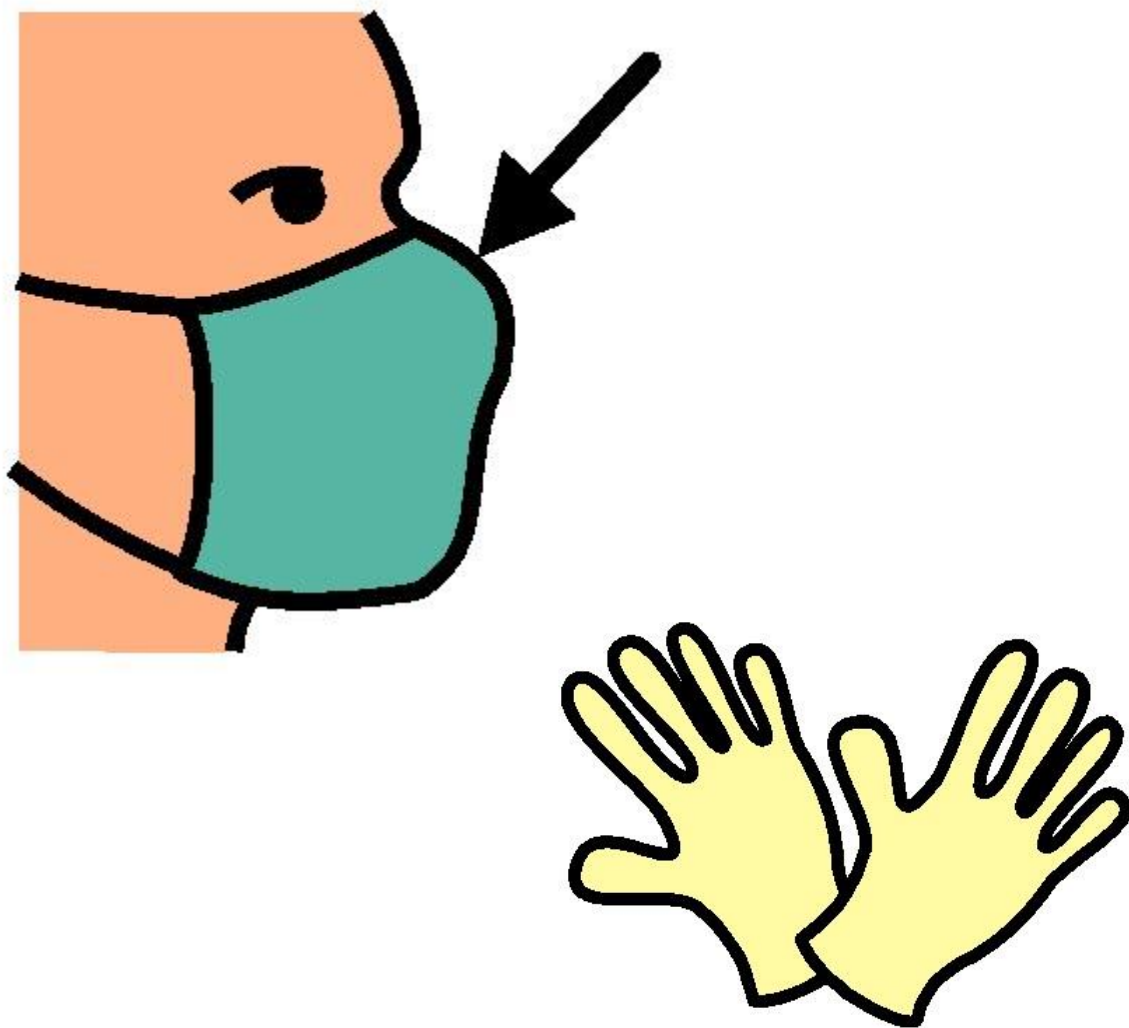




Anyone who is

get others sick.



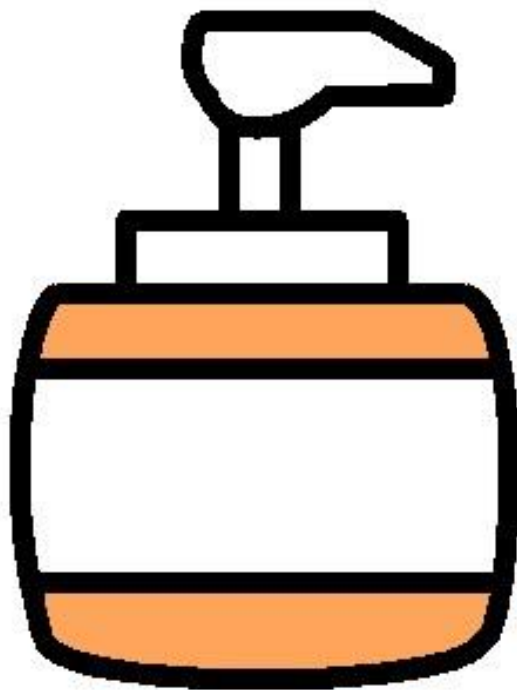
Some people might

or gloves at school.



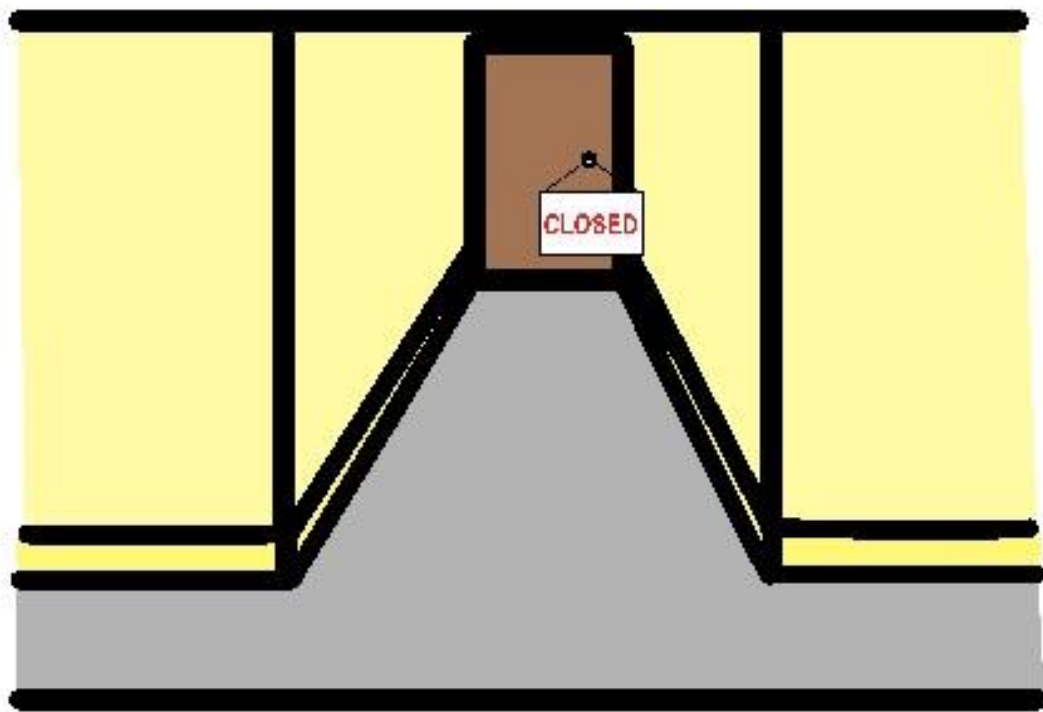
Everyone that enters the school needs to wash their hands with soap for 20 seconds.

put away.



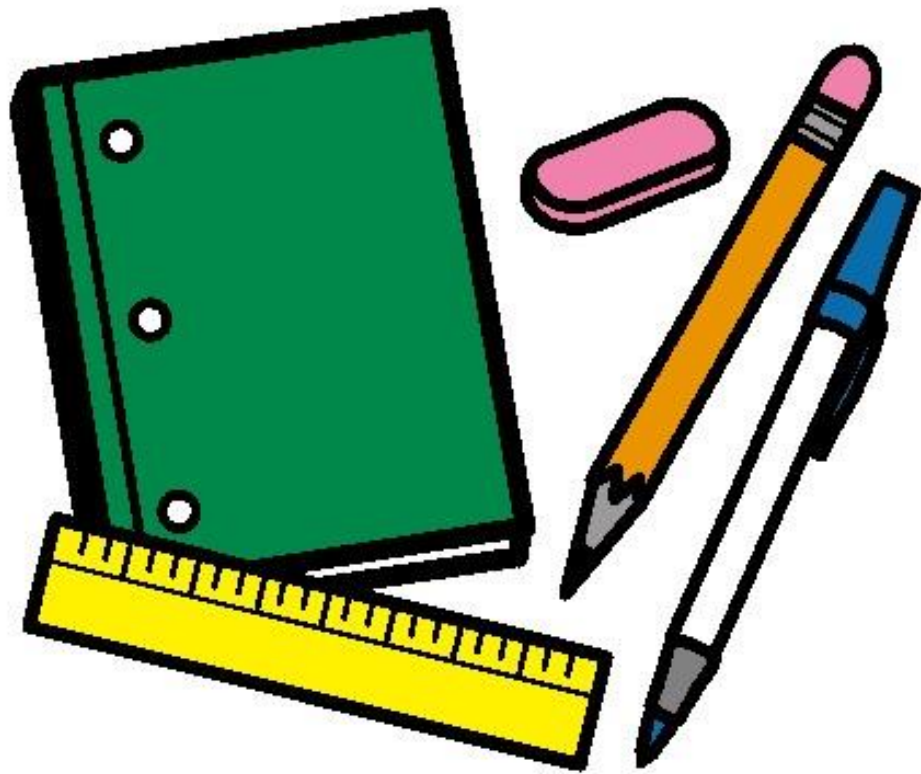




We will not be able

We will not be able to share supplies at school.



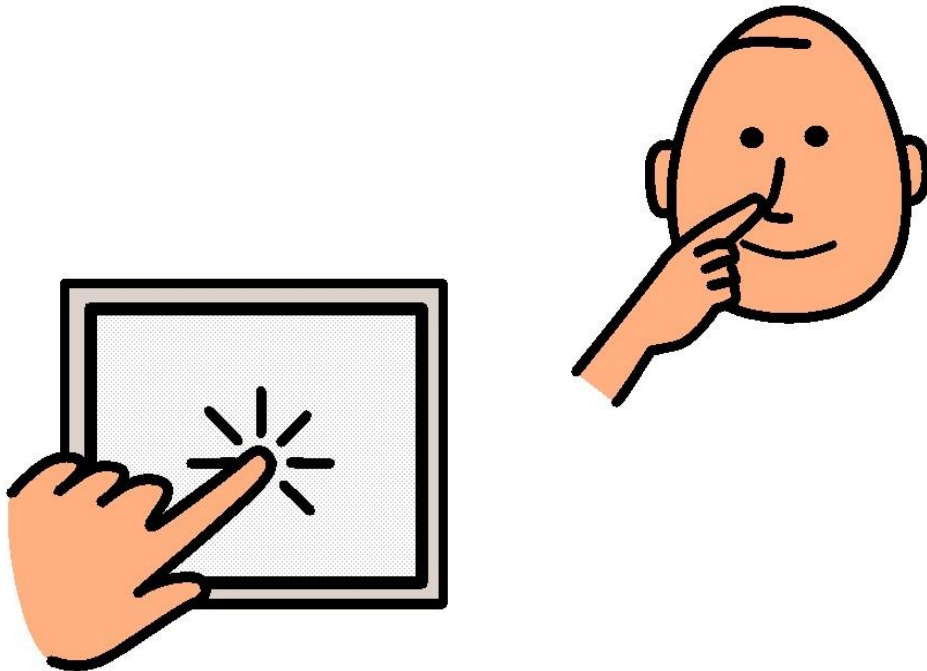
We will not be

school.



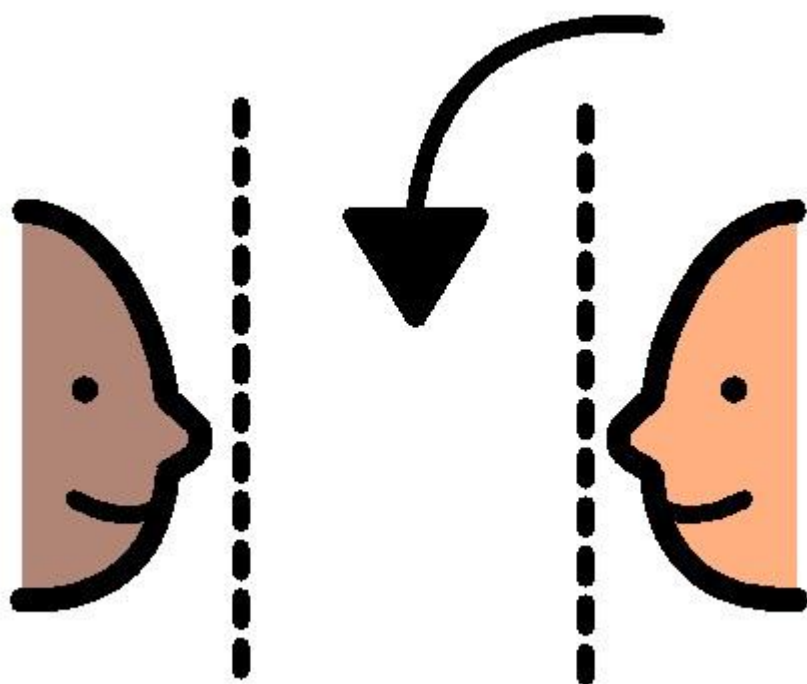
We will not be able

school.



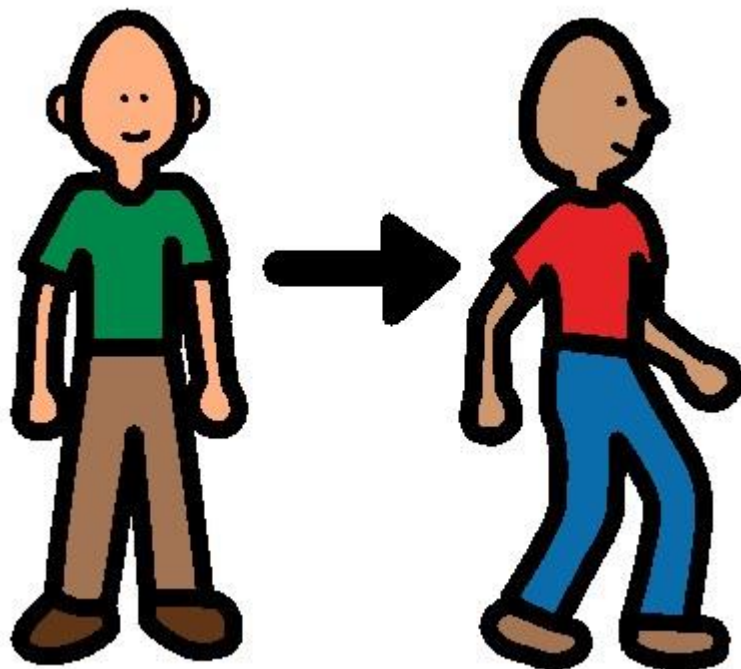
We need to limit

germs.



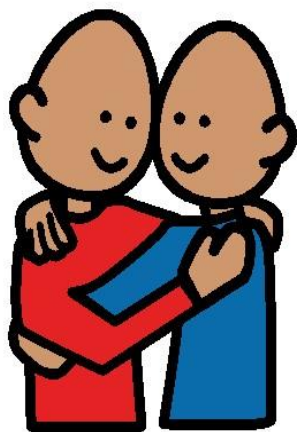
We also need to

each person.

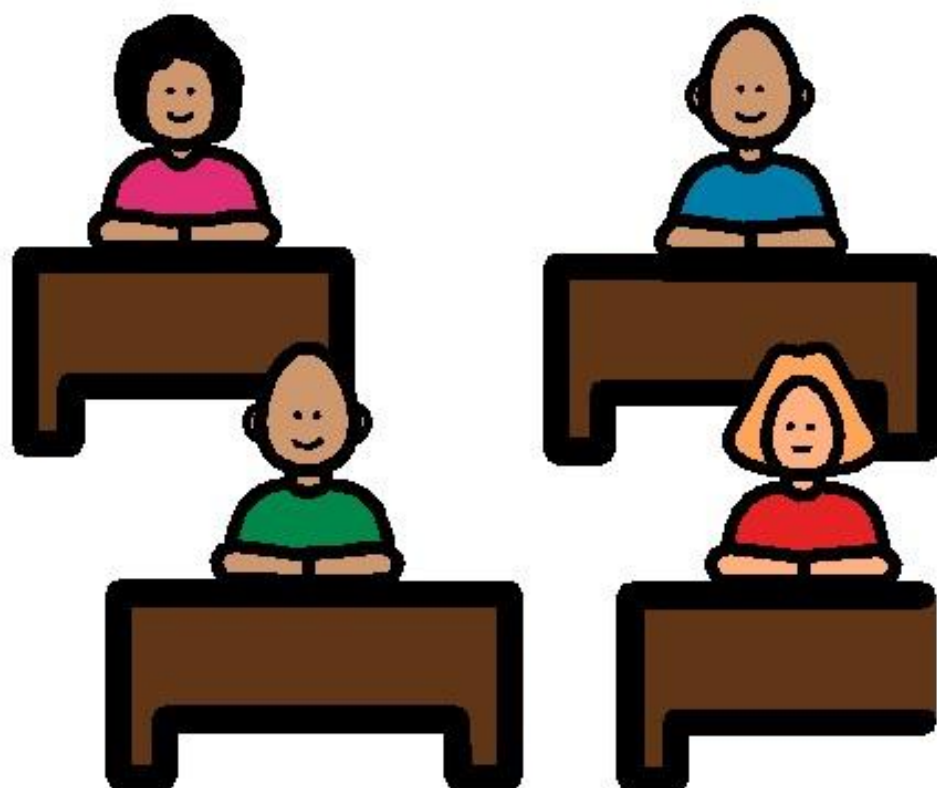


We will not be able

others at school.

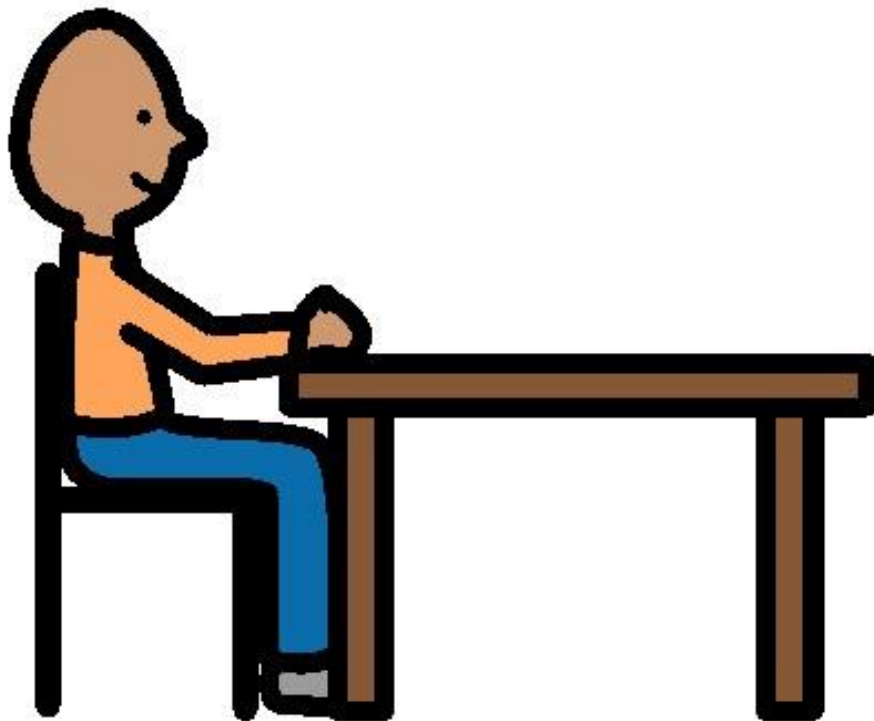




The tables will be spread out, instead of in groups.



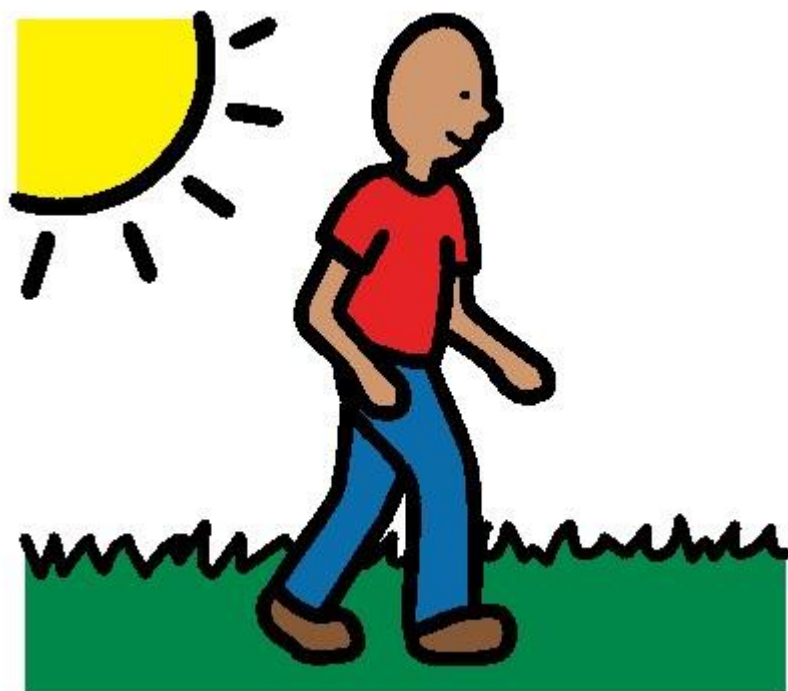
Students will sit at  
their own table.



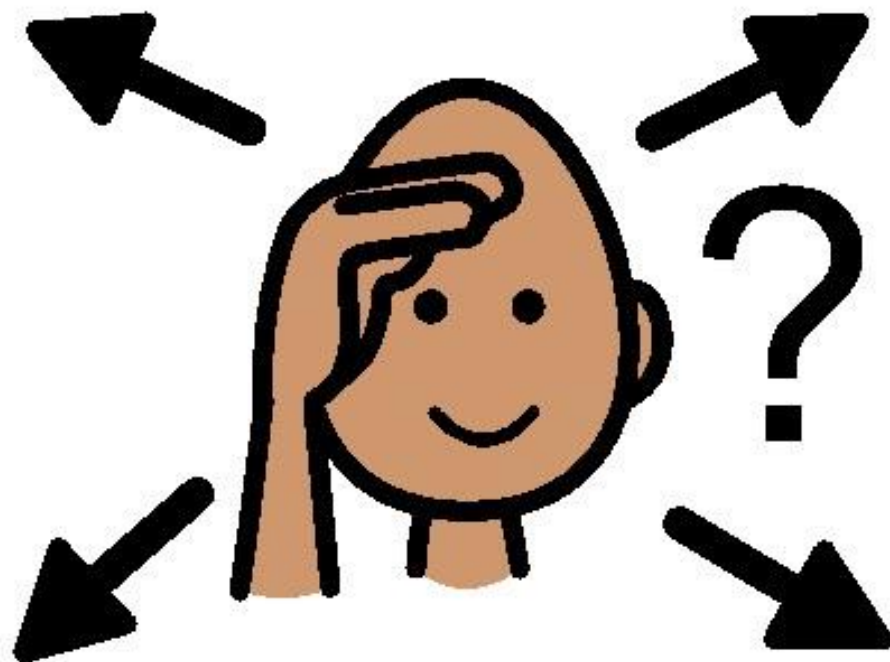
Students need to

their own.



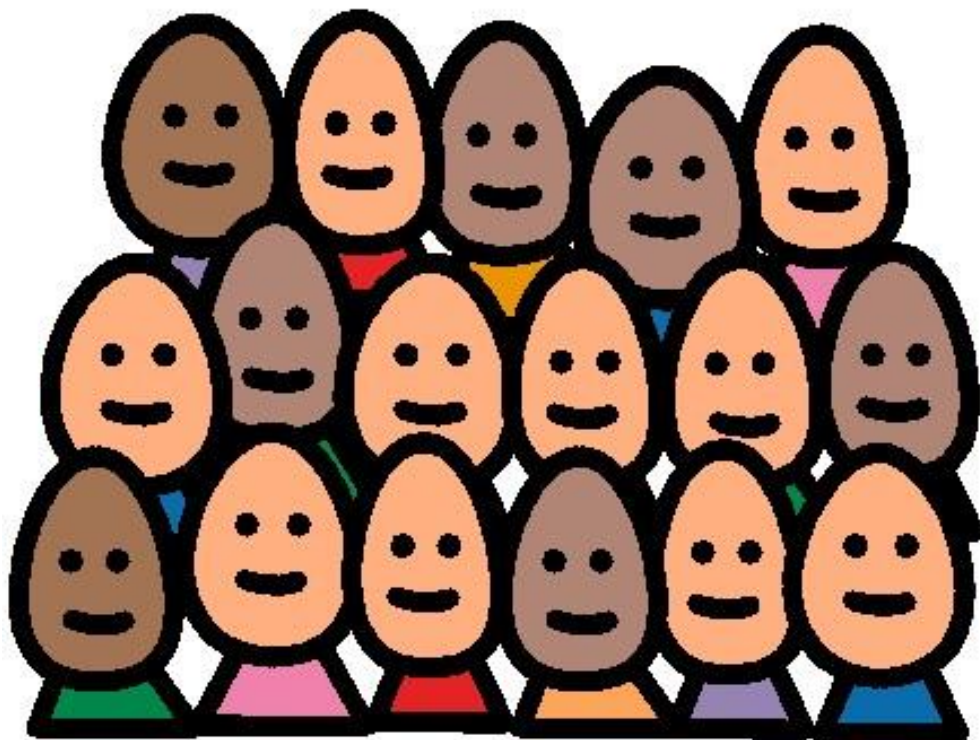
Students will need

from others.



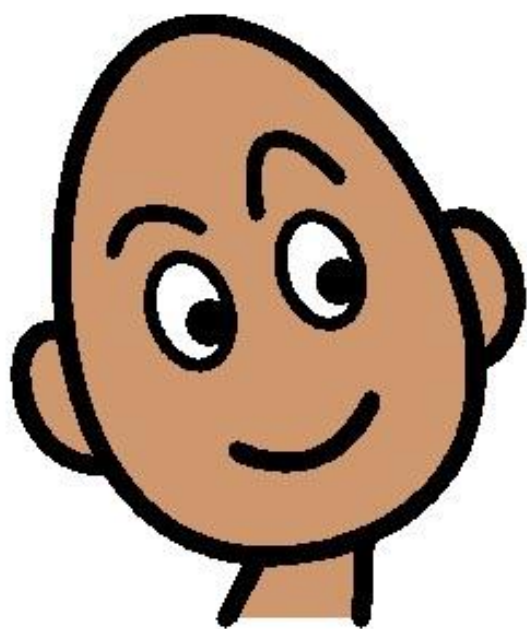
Friends from other classes might not be outside at the same time.

school!

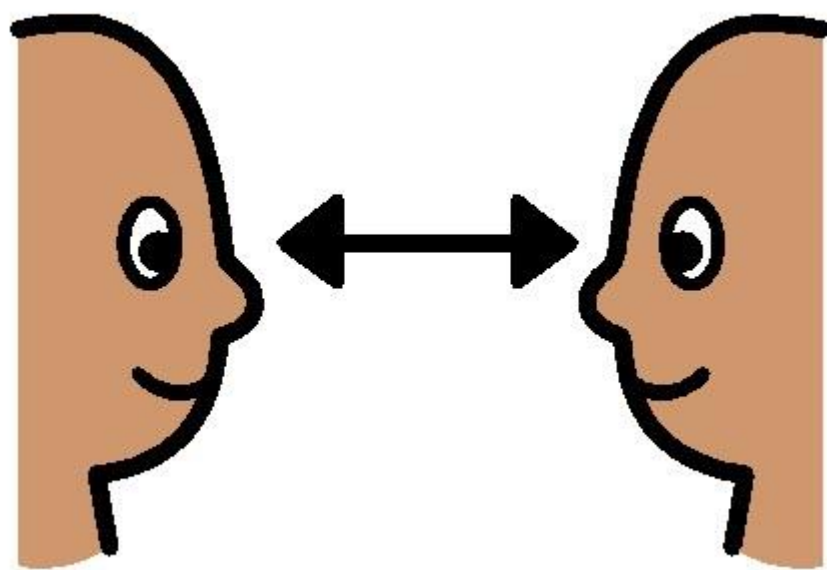


It will be nice to be  
at school again.

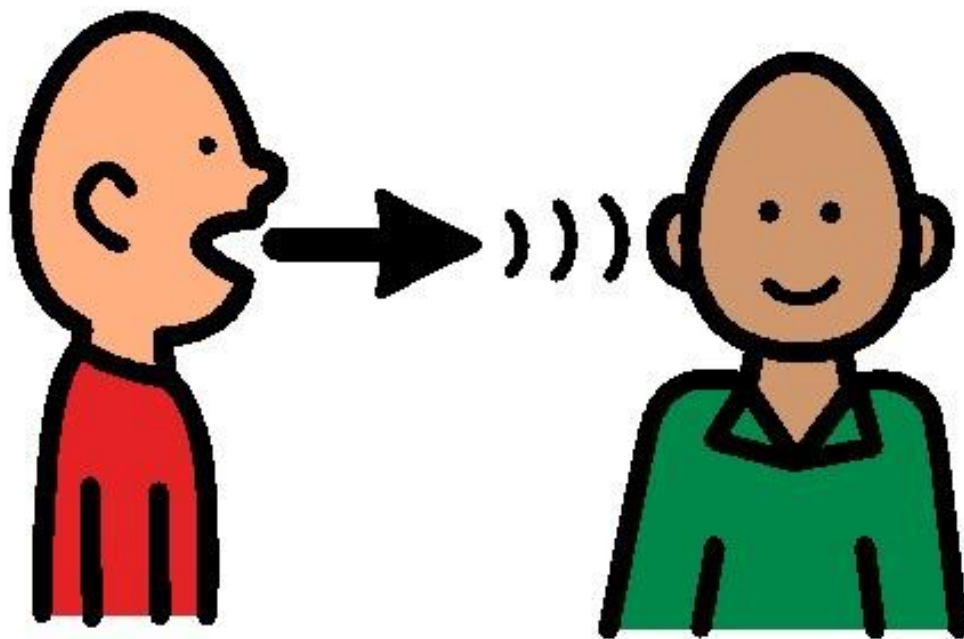




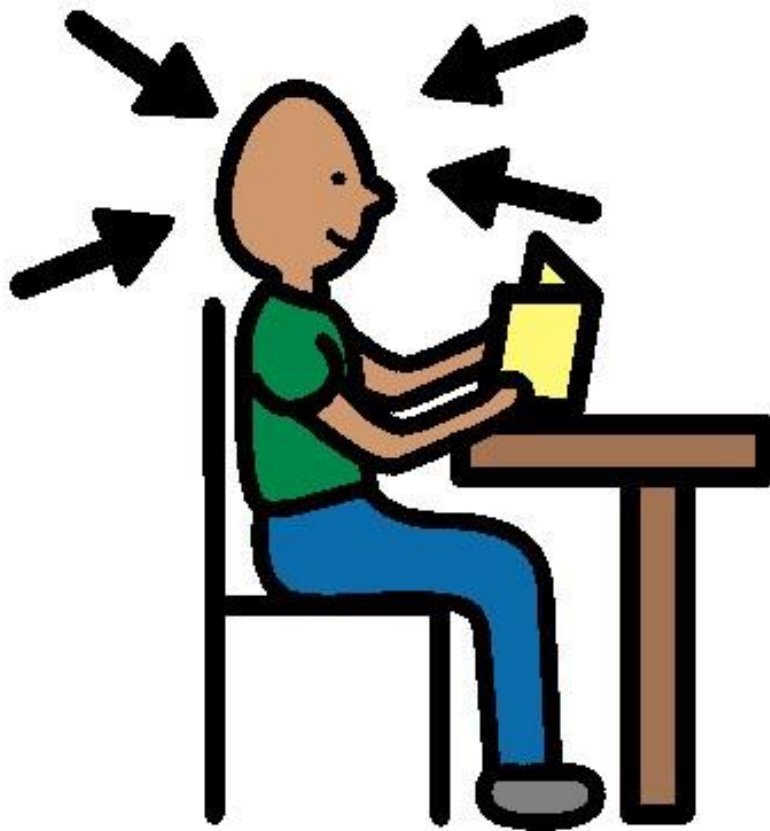
It will feel good to

distance.



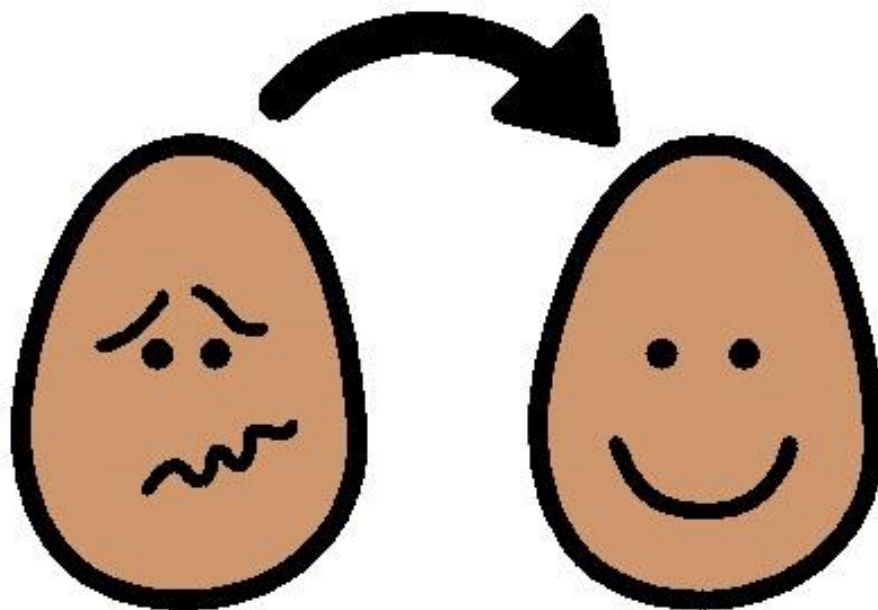
It will feel good to

will not last forever.



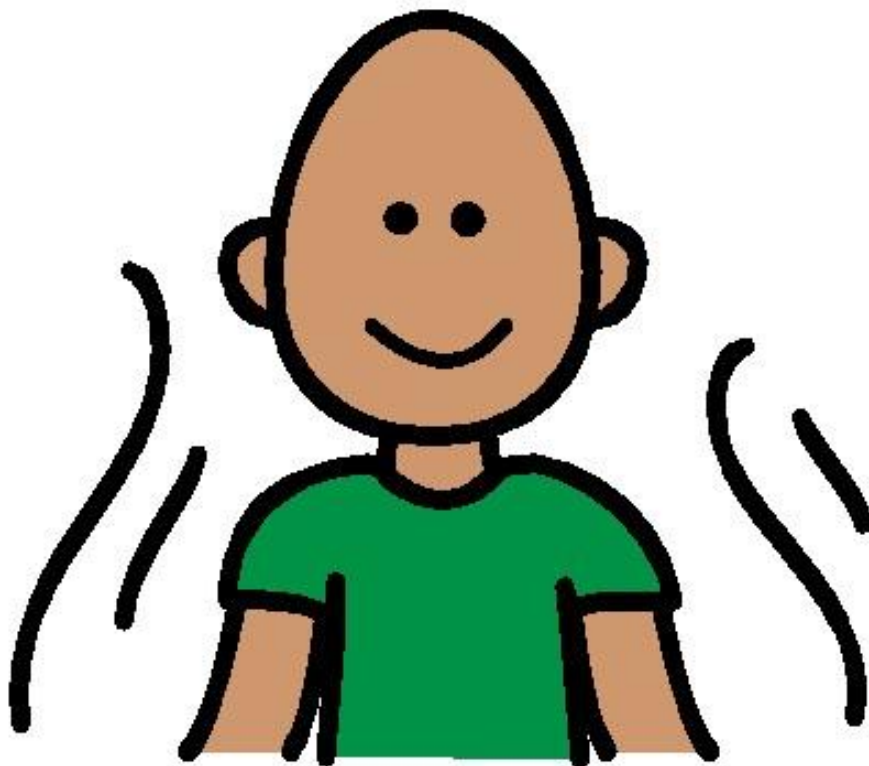
The adults and children will work hard to help keep our school clean.



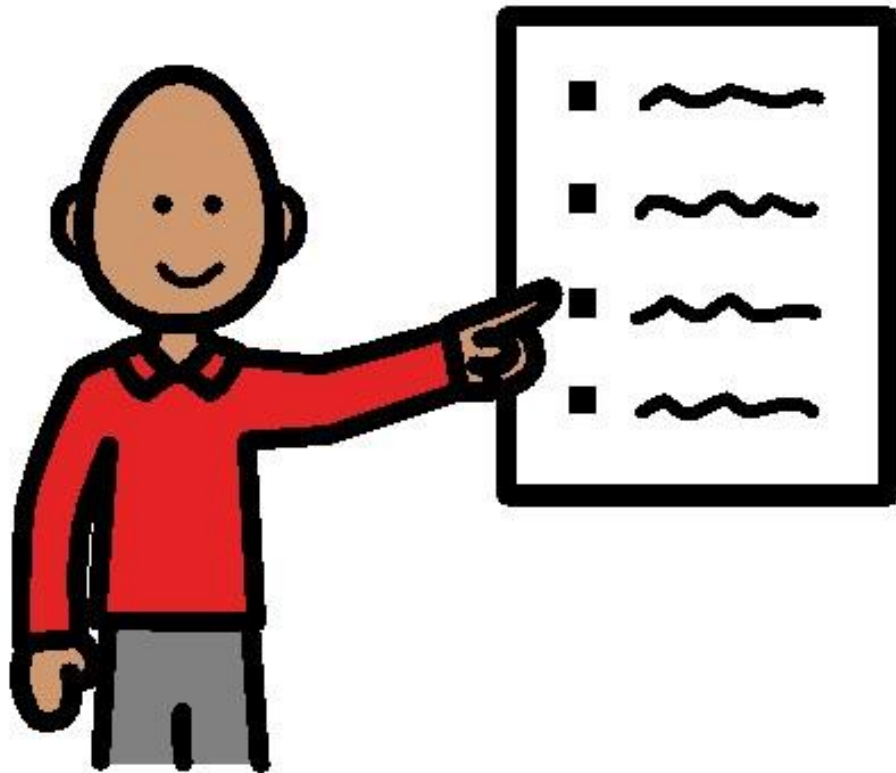
The teachers will
